This week in Towan Class the children have learnt all about the importance of rules. They have enjoyed looking at toys from both the past and the present and have had the opportunity to see and handle real 'old' toys. In music, the children have been exploring different types of tempo through dance.

This week in Summers Class, the children have learnt about their final explorer, and they each came to the decision of who they thought was the 'Greatest Explorer.' The children were able to remember lots of facts that they had learnt and use these to base their final decision on. In art this week the children have been investigating the colour green; they used blue and yellow to make green

This week in Pendower Class the children have completed their final piece in art. They made a clay tile in the shape of a house. The children used methods from previous lessons to join pieces of clay to add features to the tile. In English, the children have been writing spine poems about animals. They used a range of adjectives and verbs to describe the animal and how it moves.

Porthcurnick class has been swimming every afternoon this week. The instructors were very complimentary about how well they listened - consequently they made fantastic progress!
