- -To subitise numbers up to 5

- -To understand different types of traditions within different festivals/celebrations
- -To know and retell different Christian stories linked in with Christmas
- -To recognise and explain Autumn changes in great detail (changes of light/temperature
- Deciding whether photographs or images (e.g. from stories) depict the past
- -Begin to recognise similarities and differences between the past and today
- -To create realor imaginary maps even if features are indistinguishable

Expressive Arts and Designs

Autumn 2

- -To stop and start playing at the right time
- -Playing unturned percussion "in time" with a piece of music
- -To explore what happens when prime colours mix
- -Use paint to express ideas and feelings
- -Confidently take part in pretend play, using several objects to represent something else even though they are not similar.
