Spring Term 1 Little Carne Nursery


What will we learn?

Our investigations will be:

What happens in winter? and What is ice?

During this half term, children will be exploring freezing and melting. They will use their senses to observe ice, how it is made and what happens when it is heated up.

Children will also discover the change of season and what this looks like in their community. They will be learning what happens to the natural world around them as we explore hibernation and frost. Children will also learn about how we can keep our bodies warm in the winter as we explore clothing, hot food and drinks, hot water bottles and investigate which fabrics are best to make blankets and scarves.














Key dates
