This week, Little Carne enjoyed learning about Chinese New Year. They made Chinese lanterns and decorations for our nursery. They have also been learning about keeping warm in winter and have enjoyed dressing up in hats and gloves and have been very busy making banana bread and bird cakes.

This week, Towan Class have been exploring Chinese New Year. They have experienced eating Chinese food, making lanterns and learning all about the festival and why they celebrate it. The children have also enjoyed comparing clay with playdough. In music, they have learnt all about the beat within music and tried to find it within familiar songs.

This week, Summer Class have been busy writing the story of The Enormous Turnip. They have been using their story telling skills to write the story in the correct order and have been trying hard with spelling words and remembering to use capital letters and full stops. Also, in history, the children have been learning about Captain Scott, where he travelled and whether they thought he was a great explorer or not.

Pendower Class have been super scientists this week. They have been testing materials to see if they are waterproof. The children did this by dropping water, using a pipette, on each material and observing closely to see if the water leaked through. They found out that by adding a wax layer it made most materials waterproof. In art, they have been working in the style of artist Rachel Whiteread. They made a clay tile and joined pieces of clay to the tile using clay slip.

Porthcurnick Class have been writing some very effective headlines for a news report about the defeat of Grendel's mother by Beowulf. They also learned about the Staffordshire Hoard, an incredible Anglo-Saxon find which mainly consists of war pieces. In French, they used their knowledge of size and colour to describe different animals and in PE they challenged themselves to get better at skipping.

Portholland have been very busy with their research into Kings or Queens since 1066. They are now writing biographies about their chosen Monarch. In PE they have created some impressive balancing sequences, demonstrating excellent teamwork and awareness of keeping others safe. In art, they have been using their sketchbooks to create pages inspired by the architect and artist, Hundertwasser.

Porthluney Class have been having some very thought-provoking conversations in this week's lessons. In their RE lesson, they discussed the differing viewpoints that Christians and non-Christians may have about the stories contained in Genesis. In our Jigsaw lesson, they discussed the greatest problems that our world faces today and considered how we might work within our future lives to tackle these.

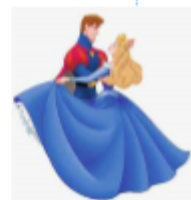
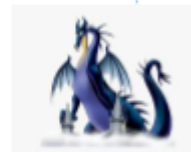
