Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

Our year 6 pupils this week have taken their SATs and we could not be any prouder! Each morning, they have joined us for breakfast and, whilst we recognise that there were some inevitable nerves, they have approached the week with a calm and considered approach, working hard, concentrating and applying all they have been taught in a mature manner. To finish their week in a more lighthearted way, they all enjoyed the first of their sailing lessons, in the sunshine, at Percuil with Roseland Paddle and Sail.

This year, Caerhays Estate are supporting Tregony Primary School's fundraising when holding their Charity Summer Fete at Caerhays Castle on 12th June 2022. Money from the raffle is donated to local charities of which Tregony School is one. In the past, schools have benefited from donations in excess of £1000. In Little Carne this week, the children have been working really hard to write their own names. We have been very proud of them. They have also been introduced to the sounds m, s and a. They have been great at spotting these sounds in words, signs and in books; see if they can do the same at home. We have also been enjoying the story Handa's Surprise. The children have explored lots of tropical fruit, by drawing, cutting and tasting them. Their favourite was drinking coconut juice straight from the coconut.

In Towan Class this week, the children have been discussing and recognising what a good friend looks like. They have also especially enjoyed learning about the differences between some countries and places around the world. In music, they have been using actions to tell the story of `The Sleeping Princess`.

In Summers Class this week, the children have been learning about the artist Clarice Cliff. They painted concentric circles on paper plates and then added black paint to make the shape of trees, using straws to blow the paint to make the trunk and branches. They have also been learning more about endangered and extinct animals.

In Porthcurnick Class, we finished our explanations about our amazing digestive system and we learned about climate and different biomes around the world. In music, we learned to recognise and play semibreves and, in art, we developed our drawing skills by trying upside down drawing!

Portholland Class have had a good week. We welcomed the Year 5s from Porthluney who have enjoyed participating in our lessons. In English, the children wrote balanced arguments. This is their first attempt at writing this genre and I have been very impressed by their work. In music, we have been learning to sing and play calypso music, which the children have enjoyed greatly.

This week, the year 6s in Porthluney Class have made us so proud, sitting their SATs with confidence and maturity. They have also enjoyed their first sailing session, learning about the functions of the different parts of the boat. The whole class has also enjoyed learning about graphic scores and matching them to different pieces of film music.
