Some of our Year 6 pupils also attended a dance workshop at The Roseland and, today, all of our preschoolers and Key Stage 1 pupils enjoyed a visit to Newquay Zoo.

Our Year 5 and 6 pupils are becoming very excited about our residential trip to London next week. We look forward to seeing you all bright and early and ready to leave by 6.30am on Monday morning.

Towan Class have spent the week discussing their thoughts and fears about moving into year 1. In writing, we have started looking at the story 'The Journey Home'. The children wrote character descriptions using expanded noun phrases.
