## Nasal Flu Vaccine

In 2022/23, all children in Primary Schools from Reception to year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. Please enter www.nhs.uk/child-flu to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate. If a consent form is not submitted your child will not be vaccinated.</u>

Little Carne Nursery have enjoyed exploring their local community this week, looking at the different buildings around the village and recognising the differences between their houses. They have also enjoyed learning about autumn and joined Towan Class for a special enrichment day. We have been very proud of how well the children have behaved when going on walks outside of the school grounds. They understood the importance of road safety, listened carefully to instruction and walked very sensibly together. Can we please remind parents to label all items bought to Nursery, including drinks bottles. Thank you.

In Towan Class, this week, we have been exploring what good turn taking looks like and what we could say in order to make sure this happens. We have also been exploring different ways of mark making. This week, we explored felt tips and how to add more detail within pictures. Towan Class had a lovely time on Thursday with their autumn day with Little Carne.

In Summers Class this week the children have been working hard, getting used to our new phonics scheme, Read Write Inc. The sessions are very different to how we used to teach phonics; however, the children have really embraced this new way of learning and are showing good progress already. In PE this week, the children have learnt about different balances and ways to help themselves balance, without falling over! In art, the children created some fantastic water/wave pictures, using different lines and mark making materials.

This week, Pendower Class enjoyed exploring their very own beach and the surrounding coastal paths. In history, we have been looking at Bonfire Night. We looked closely at sources to compare how Bonfire Night celebrations have changed over time. We also discussed if Bonfire Night should still be celebrated today.

In Porthcurnick Class, this week, we have been learning how Celtic tribes were living in Roundhouses in hillforts when the Romans invaded. We also looked closely at Roman life in Pompeii and, after watching some fascinating reconstructions, made a timeline of the fateful day when Vesuvius erupted. Ca va? In French, we learned how to say how we are feeling and, in art, we worked on our shading skills, shading in one direction, with no gaps and even tones. Portholland Class have been troubleshooting circuits and using scientific language to explain any problems that they have found. They have also continued learning about the Vikings, their invasion of Lindisfarne and the reasons that they left Scandinavia and came to Anglo Saxon England.

Porthluney Class have been continuing to learn about the ancient Greeks this week. The children have enjoyed writing descriptions of a minotaur, writing which shows great promise and bodes well for the year ahead. In our history lesson, we learnt about the Olympics. We compared the ancient and modern day Olympics and we were surprised to learn how many similarities there are between these two events. However, we do think that chariot racing should be reinstated as an Olympic sport!
