### CLASSROOM MOVES-IMPORTANT

We have some classroom moves starting on Monday so please read the attached letter to this email to find out if this will affect your child.

Little Carne Nursery have enjoyed their week, as they continue their enquiry based learning about Who am I? They have been looking closely at their faces and having a go at drawing self portraits. The children have also taken an interest in apples, so we have also carried out an apple investigation, where they have learnt the life cycle of an apple, explored them with their senses, carried out observational drawings and practised fine motor skills by tapping golf tees into the apples. Well done Little Carne Nursery.

This week Towan class has been learning about the past and present. We looked at photos of when we were babies and compared them to what we can do now. We also have been learning how to sequence in maths and the children have all done a great job.

This week, Summers Class have been working hard on improving their letter formation and handwriting. They have also been learning in history, about how household objects have changed from the 1950s/60s. In art, they have been learning about different lines, such as straight, wavy and crosshatch.

This week, Pendower Class have been learning about microhabitats in science. They went on a walk around the school to see how many they could find and to investigate the living things there. In art, the children have been using different materials to create texture.

In Porthcurnick Class this week, the children started to learn how we know about the Shang Dynasty through the discovery of oracle bones and bronze artefacts. In art, they explored making abstract



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sculptures by folding and rolling cardboard to give it structure and using the slot technique to join shapes together without glue or tape.

Portholland Class had a lot of fun in science this week, sorting materials to help Cinderella! We planned an investigation as a group and worked brilliantly in teams to use magnets, scoops and sieves. We have also had lots of fun in art with Mrs Elvy, studying the work of a Chinese sculptor and using explosions of paint!

This week, Porthluney Class have written incredible setting descriptions, describing a beach before and during a tumultuous storm. They have shown an excellent understanding of punctuation and even identified their own next steps.
