## Who am I?

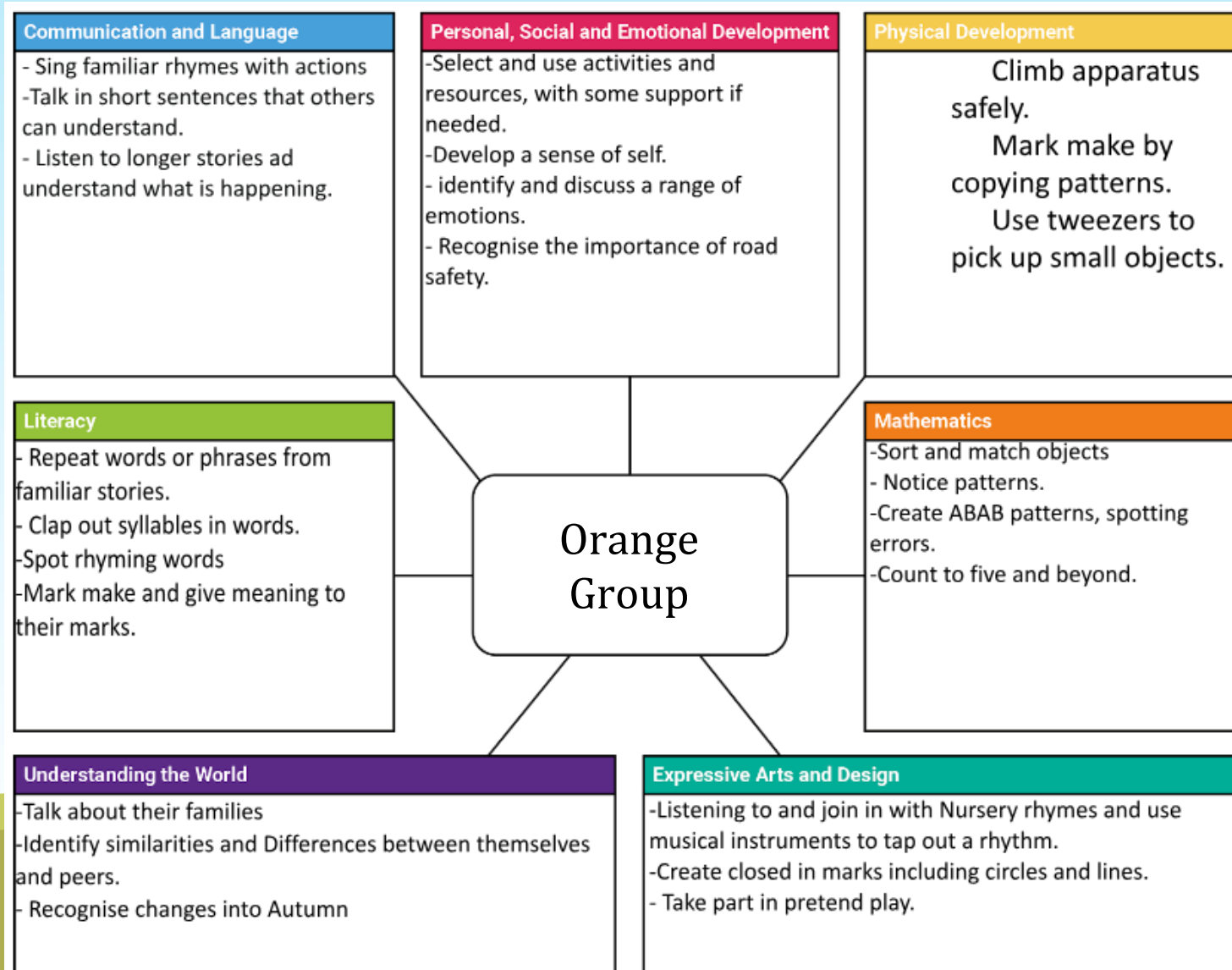
This is an introduction into Nursery as children gain a sense of self and learn about their features, likes and dislikes.

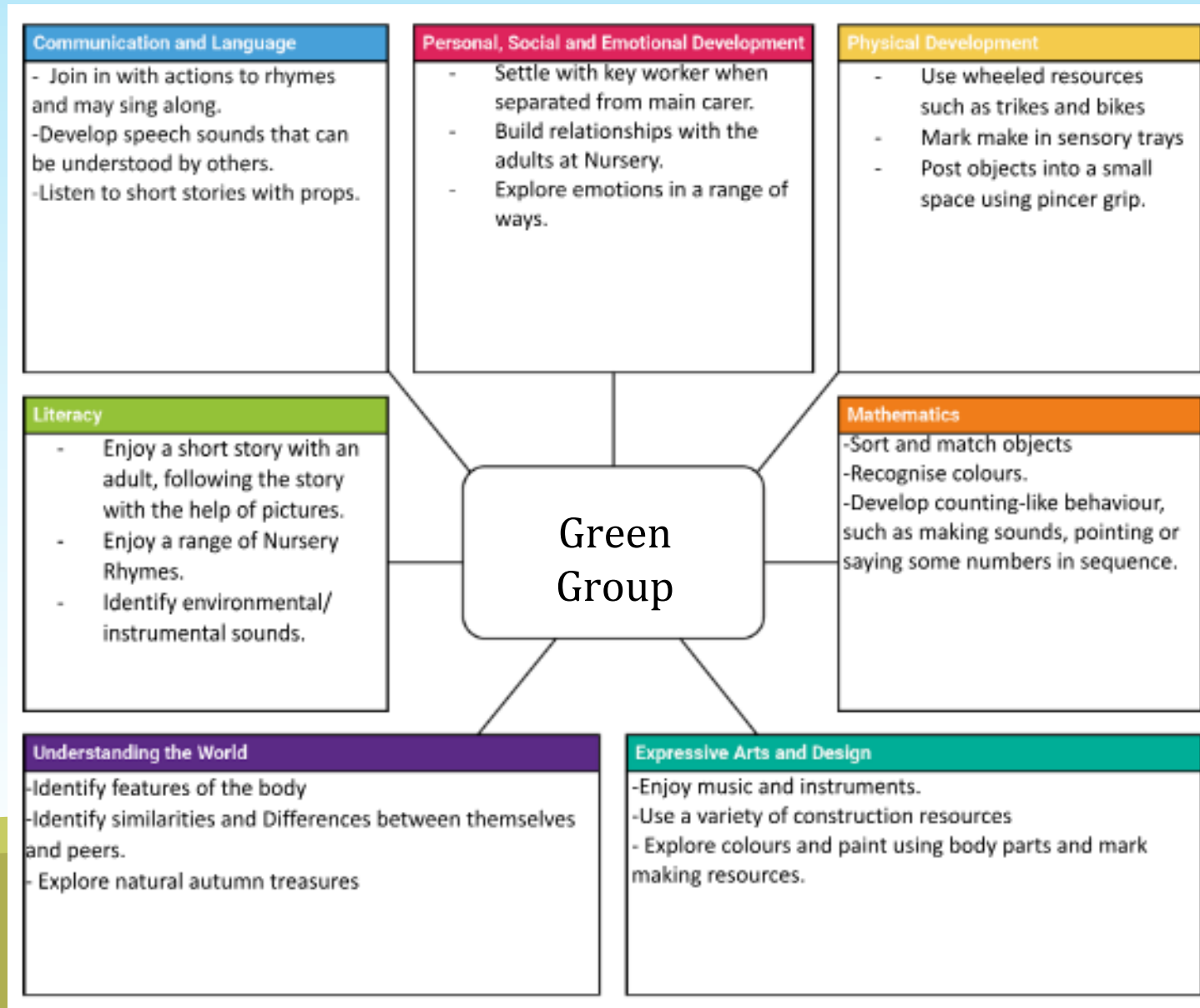
## Why are the leaves falling?

# Key Dates This Term...
