What will we learn?

What do we celebrate?

This half term the children will be exploring a variety of festivals from around the world. This will include Diwali and Christmas. We have children from different countries and cultures who may celebrate differently and as we celebrate diversity and differences, we will be exploring lots of traditions, beliefs and cultures during these holidays.

We will also be observing Remembrance and bonfire night.

This investigation will be carried out through stories, looking at real artefacts, music, songs and dance and a number of child led and adult led activities. If your family celebrates a festival or christmas tradition that you would like to share with the Nursery, we welcome you to come and see us and share ideas.

Where does light come from? (*Lights/torches, fire/ candles and the sun*)
